

INDEPENDENCE DAY 2024 CELEBRATION REPORT



Our school celebrated Independence Day with a week-long series of activities from 9th August to 15th August, 2024, fostering patriotism and cultural awareness among students and staff. The celebrations kicked off with a Tiranga Concert featuring students' performances in music and dance.

As a part of "Tiranga Tribute" initiative, students and NCC cadets honoured the national flag with a ceremonial salute, created sketches of the Tiranga and exchanged flags,

deepened their understanding of the significance of the Tiranga.

On 12th August 2024, students and staff of the school took the Tiranga Pledge, reaffirming their commitment to the nation.

One of the highlights of the week was the Tiranga Yatra in which skaters, NCC cadets, Scouts & Guides and students proudly participated, marching with the national flag throughout the school premises.
