

GUEST LECTURE ON 'CAREER IN CIVIL SERVICES'

To create an awareness about career in civil services among the school students, Army Public School Jammu Cantt organized an interactive session with JKPS, SSP Khalil Poswal, Principal Police Technical Training, Vijaypur in which 600 students from classes VIII to VIII attended the session.
