

NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY

National Mathematics Day was organized in APS Jammu Cantt on 22 Dec 2023 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Shri Srinivas Ramanujan, the great mathematical genius who made exemplary contribution to mathematics.
