

VISIT TO BAL NIKETAN (ORPHANAGE HOME) VED MANDIR, AMPHALLA, JAMMU

Ved Mandir Bal Niketan is an orphanage home that came into existence in May 1961. The building has two separate premises for boys and girls. Here, food, clothing, education, medicare, accommodation, games, vocational training, computer training and many other facilities are provided to children totally free of cost.

27 students and 4 staff members (including Principal) of APS Jammu Cantt visited Bal Niketan on 22-12-2023 and donated Grocery items worth Rs. 13,000/- to the orphanage home. The visit was scheduled under the Work Experience Project- "Care for Homeless Children" of 9th class students which focuses on every child's right to an adequate standard of living, health care, education, to play and recreation. There are total 43 children in the primary school of Bal Niketan. The staff and students of APS Jammu Cantt interacted with all the children and enquired about their standard of living, their primary requirements and the issues of homelessness in the society. The visit really proved very fruitful for students of both the schools as they spent good quality time with each other and desired for more meetings/collaborations in the future.
