

Annual Technical and Administrative Inspection (ATAI)

The Annual Technical and Administrative Inspection (ATAI) of Army Public School, Jammu Cantt, was conducted on the 22nd and 23rd of October 2024. The inspection was aimed at evaluating the school's performance in academics, administration, infrastructure, and extracurricular activities to ensure continuous improvement and adherence to standards. Before the two-day Annual Technical and Administrative Inspection, Book Inspection was conducted on 16 Oct,2024 by the senior officers deputed by the Presiding Officer.
