

Awareness Session on Offensive Behaviour, Sex Education, and Punishment under BNS

On September 11, 2024 an insightful awareness session was organized by the school, led by Principal, Ms Puneet Kour and Counselor Ms Priyanka . The session aimed to educate students on the crucial topics of offensive behaviour, sex education, and the legal consequences under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

The principal made it clear that ignorance of the law is not an excuse and that students should be aware of their rights and responsibilities. She also mentioned that schools are safe spaces, but any violation of laws will be met with serious repercussions.

The session was highly informative and provided students with a holistic understanding of offensive behavior, sex education, and the importance of staying informed about the law. It ended with an interactive Q&A session where students could openly discuss their concerns. Both Counselor Ms Priyanka and the Principal encouraged students to approach them for further guidance or support.
